They would work with the District, talk with staff and look at current policies and procedures and then generate a report to say here is where some risks are, here there is a gap in internal control and here are some recommendations on how to fix those gaps. That way the District would have something concrete to show the State Board of Accounts when they come in for an audit.

Marty added that what they have talked about over the last couple years is that the District did not have enough personnel, so they have slowly hired a couple people. He and Rachel had sat down and he said before they do a little bit more they need to have an outside company come in assess what State Board is asking of us and to really make sure with what they are planning on doing meets the requirements of State Board. He does not want to do something and hire people and then that is not the area that they are concerned about. They are concerned about somewhere else, so that is the whole idea of bringing Crown in to assess that and make sure that what we currently have and what we would like to do makes sense with State Board of Accounts.
